We are following the guidance set out by the World Wide Web Consortium's Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0. These guidelines explain how to make web content more accessible for people with disabilities, and user-friendly for everyone no matter what device or assistive technology you are using. These guidelines contain three levels of accessibility (A, AA and AAA) and our target is AA.
